



CENTRES REVEAL CRISIS IN / EARLY LEARNING / IN NT

100%	have had staff leaving the centre in the past 12 months — and of those 75% have had 3 or more staff leave the centre.
75 %	have current staff vacancies and of those 33% have 3 or more current vacancies.
25 %	currently have caps on specific rooms due to staffing constraints.
83 %	say that have had to use agency staff to meet ratio for the past 12 months, with 17% needing to use it daily and a further 25% on a weekly basis.
75 %	have waitlists for children already enrolled to pick up extra days – and of those 44% say that wait list is 12 months or more.
67 %	have waitlists for siblings of existing enrolments to get a place - and of those 13% the wait list is 12 months or more.
92%	have waitlists for new families - and of those 45% the wait list is 12 months or more.
83 %	agree that staff shortages in the past 12 months have impacted the wellbeing or safety of children.
83%	agree that staff shortages in the past 12 months have impacted educational outcomes.
92%	agree that staff shortages in the past 12 months have impacted the wellbeing or safety of educators.
