



CENTRES REVEAL CRISIS IN / EARLY LEARNING / IN QLD

95 %	have had staff leaving the centre in the past 12 months — and of those 78% have had 3 or more staff leave the centre.
88%	have current staff vacancies and of those 54% have 3 or more current vacancies.
43%	currently have caps on specific rooms due to staffing constraints.
62 %	say that have had to use agency staff to meet ratio for the past 12 months, with 27% needing to use it daily and a further 7% on a weekly basis.
77 %	have waitlists for children already enrolled to pick up extra days – and of those 21% say that wait list is 12 months or more.
64 %	have waitlists for siblings of existing enrolments to get a place - and of those 17% the wait list is 12 months or more.
80%	have waitlists for new families - and of those 27% the wait list is 12 months or more.
66%	agree that staff shortages in the past 12 months have impacted the wellbeing or safety of children.
81 %	agree that staff shortages in the past 12 months have impacted educational outcomes.
92 %	agree that staff shortages in the past 12 months have impacted the wellbeing or safety of educators.
